### BILLBOARD ON SH 242 SPEAKS FOR HEATH FOR COUNTY JUDGE

Today the Heath for County Judge campaign is announcing the first phase of its advertising campaign designed make Montgomery County taxpayers aware of little known details of the tenure of entrenched banker, real estate mogul and twenty year incumbent Alan Barber Sadler.

Making careful use of the hard earned dollars contributed by his grassroots supporters, Independent candidate and twenty year county resident Adrian Heath has installed a bulletin board bearing three key messages for county voters.

First the billboard announces the fact of the twenty year long Sadler administration and the fact that **county debt has ballooned by more than five hundred percent** under Sadler's management. "Our county population has grown 50% since year 2000, while our county debt of \$72 Million has swollen to an amazing \$540 million. That's an increase of over 500% in same time frame" said Heath.

Heath continued "Another thing, the consumer price index accounts for about 2-3% growth in the economy and cost of living each year, but **under Sadler commissioners salaries have been pumped up by 300%** in 20 years, it's a good thing Sadler is not working at the Federal Reserve with liberal fiscal policies like that!"

Finally, a line on the billboard drives home the inconvenient truth of tax increases that lay at the feet of Sadler's commissioners' court by stating the **127% growth of property taxes** since 2000. "Conservative management of the county budget means actively controlling costs and cutting waste, not hiding behind the appraisal district and taking automatic budget increases. We need truth in taxing; you either roll back the rate each year or explain how and why the budget is growing. Our county budget has grown from \$110 million to \$232 million in ten years, but if you listen to Judge Sadler – Nothing happened. That's just not acceptable," according to Heath.

In pointing to the \$80,000 dollar war chest of campaign funds Sadler has received from special interest attorneys, engineers and developers from Harris County and elsewhere, Heath expects a "massive carpet bombing campaign is about to be unleashed" to combat his modest but insistent message of fiscal responsibility, limited government and Free markets.

"Who knows what Sadler stands for or what he believes in? he hasn't bothered to create a campaign website" and " We can see the results of what he believes in our tax bills however". Heath said.

The billboard can be viewed on eastbound SH 242 between IH-45 and the San Jacinto River.
